PARTICIPANT AND SPECTATOR BEHAVIOR POLICIES

The following is a list of guidelines which each member school will enforce:

1. The Lancaster-Lebanon League encourages spectators to cheer and support their respective teams in a positive manner, but not to cheer negatively against the opponent.
2. Only team members in uniform and / or warm-ups, under the coach's supervision are permitted on the floor or field for warm-ups prior to and at half-time of games.  
Unauthorized personnel are not permitted on the playing field at the conclusion of a game.
3. Only cheerleaders for the purpose of leading cheers or promoting school spirit and authorized personnel are permitted on the sidelines or playing surface.
4. Abusive language, negative gestures, or taunting directed towards players, coaches, officials, cheerleaders, or spectators is prohibited.
5. No sirens, hand held towels, whistles, portable stereos, or noisemakers will be permitted at games. Hand held banners or hand held signs which interfere with the playing of the game will not be permitted. Such articles will be confiscated by the game manager. (Includes holding up newspapers during introduction of players)
6. The throwing of any foreign object that may harass or injure a spectator, player, or official is prohibited. (Foreign objects includes the use of laser lights)

OFFENDERS OF THESE POLICIES WILL BE ESCORTED FROM THE GYMNASIUM OR STADIUM.
